


## App Protection Policy

1. From Microsoft 365 Admin Center select **Endpoint Management**
2. Expand the left menu and select **Apps**
3. Scroll down twice and select **App Protection policies** Under **Policy**
4. Scroll up and select **+Create Policy**. Click the down arrow and select Windows 10
5. Click in the name box and type **App Protection Policy**. Press Enter.
6. Click in the description box and type **Secure application data**. Press Enter.
7. Scroll down and select **Next**.
8. Scroll down again and click on **Add** under **protected Apps**
9. Select the following Apps



10. Click on **OK**. Select Next
11. Turn on **Windows information protection mode** to **Silent**
12. Click on **Next** to continue. Keep scrolling down and turn on **Enterprise Server Proxy list**. Also turn on **Enterprise IP Ranges list**.
13. Scroll down and turn on **Prevent corporate data from being accessed.....**
14. Scroll down and turn on **Show the Enterprise data protection icon**
15. Keep scrolling down and under **Access set the minimum required for the PIN to 8**
16. Keep scrolling down and make sure to read the available settings as you scroll down
17. Click on **Next** to continue.
18. Click on **Select Groups to include**. Click on the **AG Group** then click **Select**.
19. Scroll down and click on **Next**.
20. Scroll down to review your settings then click on **Create**
21. Select the **App Protection Policy** and click on **Properties**
22. Scroll down and view all the properties
