# Using Exchange Admin center to recover deleted emails

## Use new EAC for recovering deleted messages

- 1. In the new EAC, navigate to **Recipients > Mailboxes**.
- 2. Select the mailbox for which you want to recover deleted messages, and click on the display name.
- 3. Under More actions, click Recover deleted items.
- 4. Enter values for each or either of the filter criteria from the drop-down lists.
- 5. Click Apply filter.

### Recovering deleted messages

Step 1. The user who is deleting the message must have the correct admin permission in to recover the message. The permission needed is import export permission. Let's give that permission.
